What is “collegiate level”?

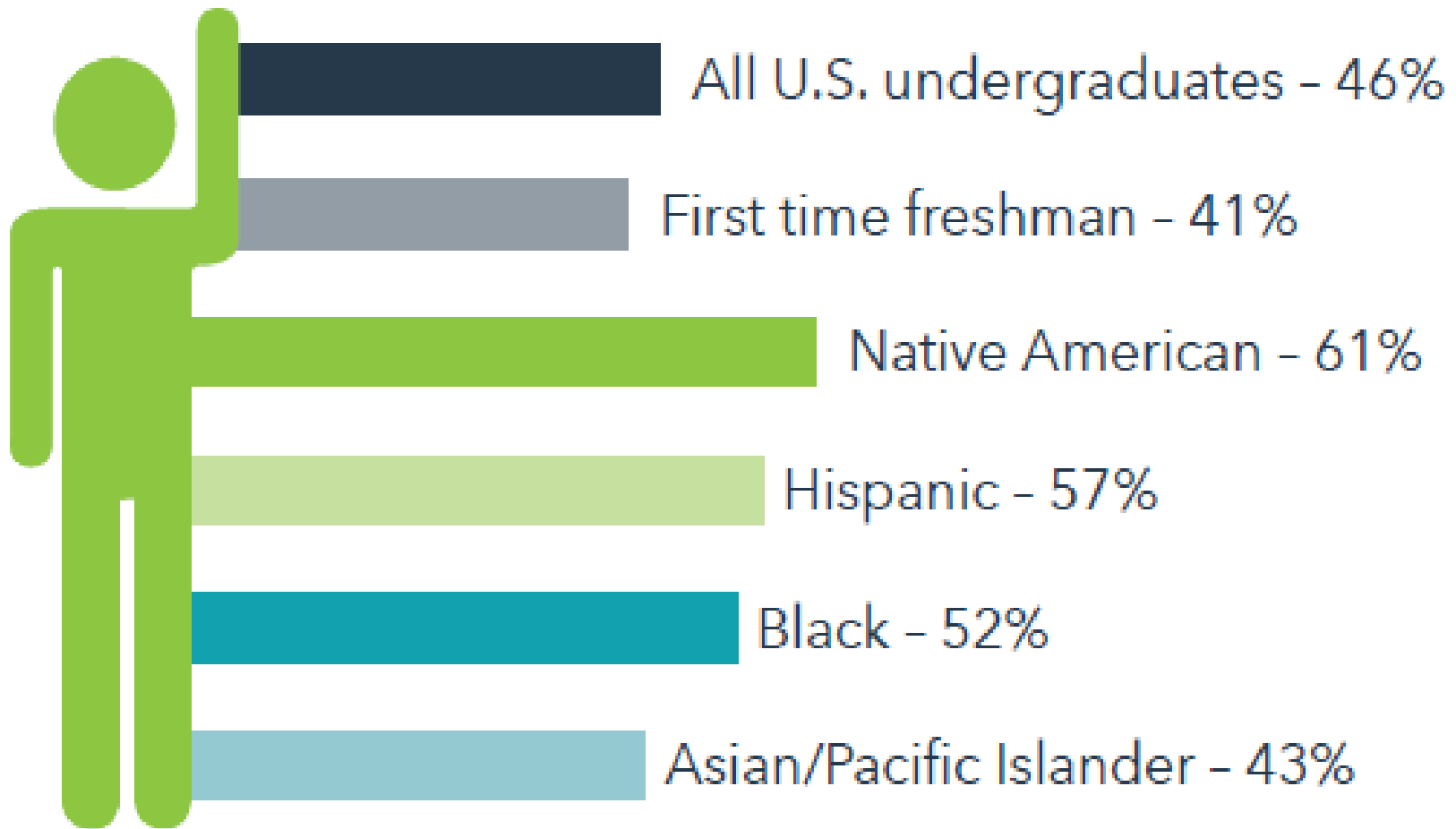
It has become a very blurred line

- Traditional college classes taken at college
- AP Courses at high school
 - AP Calculus: 300,000 students take the exam.
 - BC Calculus: 100,000 students take the exam.
- Community Colleges
 - 800,000 Associate Degrees
