4. The participants were continuously monitored during the competition, and they were separated by an empty space, if possible.
5. No aids were permitted other than scratch paper, graph paper, ruler, compass, and protractor. NO CALCULATORS, SMART WATCHES, OR CELLPHONES WERE USED.
6. Participants had exactly 3 hours of working time. (See 2020 Invitational Competitions Teacher's Manual for the AMC Policy on Students with Accommodation Plans.)
7. No students were permitted to proctor or grade the competition.
8. After the competition, the answer sheets were kept secure and no changes were made to the answers.
9. No parent or legal guardian assisted in the administration of the competition. No parent or legal guardian was present in the room during the administration of the competition.
